StreamSweepers has trained and employed dozens of Central Virginia's young men and women and transformed their perspective on what might be possible for them to achieve and how to impact their community.

Sweepers take to our rivers in canoes and complete ecological assessments using handheld GPS units. After the assessment is complete they get to the hard work of removing trash from our rivers – tons of trash over the four years. They've removed everything from small items like bottles and cans to larger items like tires, appliances, heating oil tanks and more.

Over the last four years we assessed and cleaned three rivers in their entireties: Rapidan, Robinson and Hughes. Last year we began providing maintenance cleaning on the Rapidan

and Robinson to keep them free of harmful trash. These rivers are drinking water sources for many communities.

In 2017, we will continue our work in by addressing the upper Rappahannock in three counties: Rappahannock, Fauquier and Culpeper. We will add volunteer stream cleanups to our program for the first time this year. It is our goal to broaden community awareness of the need for clean water and create partnerships to harness the power of volunteers. We also plan to expand our service area to include Southwest Virginia.

StreamSweepers is a program of the Center for Natural Capital, a 501-c-3 charitable organization, based in Orange, VA, that provides water, landscape and energy services to improve the health of people, We've received the American Canoe Association's 2014 Sanctioned Event of the Year, and a Commendation from Virginia's General Assembly in 2015.
